BRDWID Accomplishments

- ✓ No major milestones to report this month.

BRDWID Work-in-process

- ✓ Work on fire hydrants, shut-off valves, air-relief valves and other priority maintenance activities as approved for prioritization by the Board at the march meeting is in-process. (Update from the DM.)
 - "As a result of the BRFD Fire Hydrant testing (72 hydrants need immediate attention) and issues with isolating streets during the recent main line water system repairs, it is apparent we need to get the fire hydrants inspected/repared and main water line valves in the streets identified and exercised/repared. In addition, the volunteer team of Bob Hardin and Dan Goodwin identified several repair items at each of the well sites that need attention including facia board replacements, painting, fence repairs, and lighting inside the buildings."
- ✓ Budget Committee has met and reviewed the entire budget. Good discussion. Proposed FY2026/2027 Budget to be presented at May Board meeting for a vote. (Update from Treasurer.)
- ✓ Ad-hoc technology working group evaluating updates to website. Harry Markley is the Board liaison.
